The Liquor Licensing Board ("the Board") considered the above application as well as the reports and comments made by the Police at its meeting on 10 July 2012. Members also noted your written representation.

During the meeting, the Assistant Secretary (Liquor Licences) Kowloon indicated that a letter had been sent by the Tobacco Control Office (TCO) to the premises stating that illegal smoking activities and ashtrays were found at the premises during their site inspection on 2 December. In view of this, the TCO had reminded the person-in-charge of the premises.

Having considered whether the applicant was a fit and proper person to hold the licence, whether the premises were suitable for selling or supplying intoxicating liquor and in all the circumstances whether the grant of the licence was contrary to the public interests, the Board agreed to approve the application for renewal of liquor licence (with bar endorsement), and renew the liquor licence for 12 months, with the retention of the existing additional licensing conditions on the liquor licence.

You may refer to section 17(5) of the Dutiable Commodities (Liquor) Regulations (Cap. 109B) for the right of appeal against the above decision of the Board. An extract of
